	<ul> <li>Vineyard: The Three small vineyards are within the heart of the Willamette Valley in Oregon: Miracle Vineyard is 3 acres, Newton Creek Vineyard is 1 acre, and Deerhaven Vineyard is 5.5 acres. Deerhaven was added and altogether they have 8.5 acres of vineyard at the base of the Oregon Coastal Hills in Philomath, Oregon.</li> <li>Soil: Clayey, smectite, mesic, mostly Philomath silty clay</li> <li>Year Planted: 1997</li> </ul>
Vineyard Notes:	Elevation: 30 feet
Winemaking Notes:	<b>Vinification:</b> Whole clusters pressed and fermented in 100% stainless steel tanks with a long cool fermentation to retain fruit flavors and aromas
	<ul> <li>Bouquet: A light scent of honeysuckle, citrus and a hint of spice introduce the wine.</li> <li>Flavor: Rich creamy pear, apple, Meyer lemon, and peach flavors mingle, balanced by a little hit of citrus and a refreshing minerality.
