




San Floriano - San Floriano Vineyard, San Luis Obispo, CA

Appellation: San Luis Obispo County

Type: Red

Grape Varietals: Lagrein, Merlot, Syrah



Region: Edna Valley AVA

Vineyard: Designated, limited production, Estate wine. One-acre vineyard comprised of two Lagrein clones. Piedra Creek Winery is the first winery in the Central Coast, and

Vineyard Notes: one of the only few producers of the Lagrein grape in North America.

Winemaking Notes: Production: 202 cases produced.

Bouquet: Aromas of buttery cherry pastry, leather, and vanilla nougat comprise the satiny medium-to-full body followed by a long, creamy mocha, spiced berry, and

mineral finish.

Flavor: A superb sipper or table wine. Lagrein, the blue-black grape, native of the Alto Adige region of northern Italy, is the dominant grape. The resulting wine is dense,

concentrated, and yet very balanced and elegant.

Tasting Notes: Food Pairings: Beef, Deer, Lamb.
