Rossi d'Angera Vermouth Rosso is made from selected wines and a hydroalcoholic infusion of over 31 botanicals.

Classic vermouth obtained from the union of Cortese and Trebbiano white wines with hydroalcoholic infusions. In addition to bitter-toned herbs and roots such as cinchona, rhubarb and gentian, the infusion also contains some herbs typical of the lake and pre-Alpine area.

Tasting Notes

Color: A deep amber color tending towards orange.

Bouquet: Intense, aromatic gentian, cinchona, and rhubarb with persistant hints of medicinal herbs, absinthes, yarrows, and citrus.

Taste: Round, ample, vigorous with spicy, vinous notes and a long finish.

Serving suggestion:Try it neat, on the rocks or ask for the dedicated cocktail list.

Alcohol: 16%
